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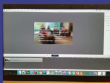

*Open DVD in VLC to record. Use Screenflow to film the DVD. Adjust the time in order to meet the length of the film. Then edit the film.

How to Edit
the Video

*When you stop record and it will show up to be ready to edit. The most important to do before start edit is **save** in the file called Language Backup captured movies. So it won't be lost or messed up to start again. Then crop the screen to fit the video. Change to match Canvas size required. **Save** it again and done!
